Resolution Setting Capacity by Grade Level for 2011-2012 and 2012-2013

Whereas

- San Carlos Charter Learning Center (SCCLC) submitted its Charter Renewal Petition to the San Carlos School District (SCSD) on February 27, 2012; and
- the SCSD Board approved the Charter Petition Renewal on March 8, 2012; and
- the new Charter increases SCCLC's enrollment capacity to 400 learners; and
- SCCLC is admitting 44 learners in kindergarten and 1st grade for 2012-2013, an increase of 8 learners above the 2011-2012 nominal enrollment; and
- SCCLC has finite resources that must be managed to meet the educational goals described in its Charter, which includes managing learner capacity by grade level,

it is therefore resolved by the governing board of SCCLC that

grade level enrollment capacity for the 2011-2012 school year be set at 36 learners per grade for Kindergarten through 6th grade, 28 learners for 7th grade, and 26 learners for 8th grade; and that grade level enrollment capacity for the 2012-2013 school year be set at 44 learners per grade for Kindergarten and 1st grade, 36 learners for 2nd through 7th grade, and 26 learners for 8th grade.
