General Responsibilities:

Fiduciary responsibility, and exercises the non-profit's "corporate powers"

Specific responsibilities from the Charter:

- Charter implementation and renewal
- Selection of staff
- Budget development and approval
- School calendar
- School policies and procedures



The GC consists of...

- Five (5) family members (parents/guardians) of SCCLC learners
- One (1) SCCLC educator representative
- One (1) member of the community*
- One (1) member of the business community*
- One (1) representative of the San Carlos
 School District

*: not a SCCLC parent/guardian

How does the GC work?

- Meeting in public (Brown Act)
- No individual power authority only when acting as a Board during a meeting, or as delegated
- Works closely with SCCLC's administration
- Not involved in the day-to-day, operational running of the school
