Resolution Setting Capacity by Grade Level for 2013-14

Whereas

- San Carlos Charter Learning Center (SCCLC) submitted its Charter Renewal Petition to the San Carlos School District (SCSD) on February 27, 2012; and
- the SCSD Board approved the Charter Petition Renewal on March 8, 2012; and
- the new Charter increases SCCLC's enrollment capacity to 400 learners; and
- SCCLC admitted 44 learners in kindergarten and 1st grade for 2012-2013, an increase of 8 learners above the 2011-2012 nominal enrollment; and
- SCCLC shall be admitting 44 learners to each incoming kindergarten class beginning with 2013-14
- SCCLC has finite resources that must be managed to meet the educational goals described in its Charter, which includes managing learner capacity by grade level,

it is therefore resolved by the governing board of SCCLC that

grade level enrollment capacity beginning with the 2013-2014 school year be set at 44 learners per grade for Kindergarten through 2nd grade, 36 learners for 3nd through 7th grade, and 35 learners for 8th grade.
